



CALL FOR VISITING PROFESSORS AT RISK

A.Y. 2019/2020

Application deadline: 12 pm on October 19, 2020

Art. 1 - Scope

The University of Milan, in the framework of the initiatives promoted by the roundtable for "Reception and Integration in the University", as a member of the international network "[Scholars at Risk](#)" (SAR) and its Italian division SAR-Italia, and in view of the growing number of scholars at risk around the world applying for protection with European Union (EU) universities, issues a call for applications for a position of visiting professor at risk.

Art. 2 - Requirements

Applicants must, on pain of exclusion, meet the following requirements:

a) Being a foreign citizen who:

1. holds refugee status in Italy or a EU member state; or
2. is entitled to subsidiary protection in Italy or a EU member state; or
3. is seeking asylum or protection in Italy or a EU member state.

Candidates falling into one of the above categories shall include evidence of refugee / subsidiary protection / asylum or protection seeker status in their application.

b) Being employed as a lecturer at an international university or research institution or, alternatively, being qualified for university teaching, with documented work experience at international universities or research institutions.

c) Being proficient in English.

Art. 3 - Application and Deadline

Applications shall be drawn up using the form attached hereto (Annex I), and sent to international.visiting@unimi.it, with the following attachments:

- 1) self-certification of the requirements referred to in art. 2, a) (Annex II);
- 2) copy of an identity document/passport;
- 3) CV and publications;
- 4) programme of training activities to be carried out (Annex III);
- 5) letter of acceptance from a Milan University Department signed by the Department Head or his/her deputy (Annex IV).

Applicants need not hand in a printed copy of the online application to the competent Office. Applications must be submitted by **12 pm on October 19, 2020 (Italian time)**.

Art. 4 - Duration of Stay and Compensation



The minimum period of stay is two months, with at least **16 hours** of training and/or seminar activities to be carried out on an ongoing basis within **Bachelor's, Master's, or single-cycle degree programmes, and PhD programmes**. The University shall pay the Visiting Professor a gross all-inclusive fee of **€ 8,400**.

Classes and / or seminars shall be held during academic sessions, and completed by the end of the academic year (September 30, 2021).

The selected Visiting Professor shall sign a letter of appointment by the University specifying his/her training and seminar activities, compensation and timeline.

The Visiting Professor shall carry out support training and seminar activities, possibly as a co-instructor. Under no circumstances will the Visiting Professor be a regular professor.

The aforementioned all-inclusive fee is gross of any withholdings and contributions to be paid by the recipient. The compensation will be paid as a lump-sum upon completion of the programme, following the submission of the *Activity Log* pursuant to art. 6.

Visiting professors from EU member states holding a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) will enjoy health care during their stay in Italy. EU citizens without EHIC, as well as professors from non-EU countries, may access health care services provided they take out an insurance policy at their own expense.

Third-party liability shall be covered by the University insurance policy.

The entry to, and residence in, Italy of Visiting Professors shall be governed by Italian national laws and local regulations.

Art. 5 - Selection Process

Candidates will be selected by a special Committee appointed by the Rector based on the following criteria:

- scientific and academic profile (up to 12 points);
- programme of training activities to be carried out (up to 12 points);
- language proficiency, as (self-)certified (up to 6 points).

The results of the selection process will be announced by **October 28, 2020**.

Art. 6 - Reporting Requirement

At the end of his/her stay, the Visiting Professor shall produce an *Activity Log* using the *template* provided by the competent Office.

Art. 7 - Public Procedure
